- *promoting public access to cultural “events” and*
- *increasing cultural expressions.*

Guidelines

- Only projects that take place and benefit Hood River County will be considered.
- Individuals, nonprofit organizations, and for-profit organizations may apply.
- Please submit the original application and 5 copies.
- Applications must be postmarked on or before November 1, 2019.
- Completed applications must be typed or clearly handwritten.
- We encourage you to include other funding sources for your project within the budget to strengthen your proposal.

- Projects must relate to the priorities for Hood River County as outlined in the Cultural Plan for Hood River County that can be viewed under the Cultural Plan tab on the homepage of this website.
