- Applications must be received by midnight on December 1, 2020.
- We encourage you to include other funding sources for your project within the budget to strengthen your proposal.

- Projects must relate to the priorities for Hood River County as outlined in the Cultural Plan for Hood River County that can be viewed under the Cultural Plan tab on the homepage of this website.
- Checks will be awarded for selected projects in January.
- A final report will be required of grantees.
